

Clyde M. Hunt Memorial Student Paper Award (established in 1993)

Description: To recognize a student paper of exceptional interest and applicability to the field of Broadcast Engineering.

Prize: First prize: \$250, Certificate and an all expense paid trip to the Annual Broadcast Symposium to present the winning paper; Second and Third prize: \$250.00, Certificate, and complimentary registration to the Annual Broadcast Symposium. (For coauthored papers, only principal author receives prizes (first, second, or third).

Funding: Honoraria funded by the Clyde M. Hunt Memorial fund; administered by the IEEE Foundation. Travel and Symposium registration funded by the IEEE Broadcast Technology Society.

Eligibility: Any student, undergraduate or graduate, pursuing a course of study in a field related to broadcast engineering is eligible. The student need not be a member of IEEE or BTS.

Basis for Judging: General quality, extent of original work, timeliness, and significance of the contribution to the broadcast engineering profession. The paper must be of sufficient quality to warrant publication in the *Transactions*.

Presentation: Given aperiodically, however presentation to be made at Annual Broadcast Symposium.
