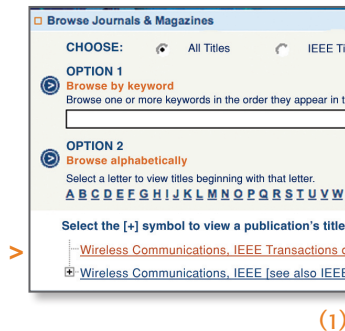
Receive Automatic RSS and E-mail Alerts to Stay Updated

What is RSS?

- RSS stands for Really Simple Syndication
- An RSS feed (also an XML or news feed) is a listing of a website's content to which you subscribe using an RSS or news reader
- It is updated whenever new content is published to the site

Sign Up for RSS Feeds

- 1 Go to the journal home page of interest

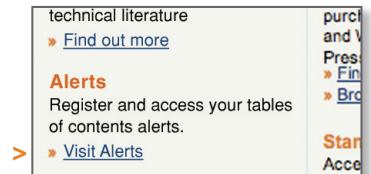
- 2 Click **RSS Feed for Latest Issue** to download the XML feed

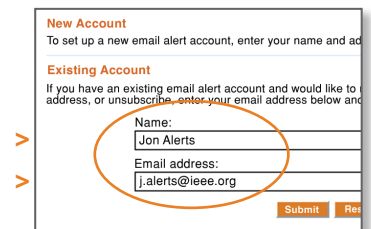
Sign up for E-mail Alerts

- 1 Go to **Alerts** from the IEEE Xplore home page



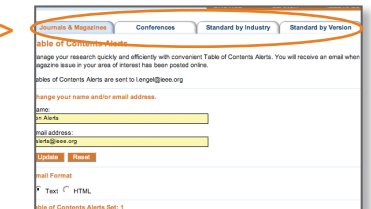

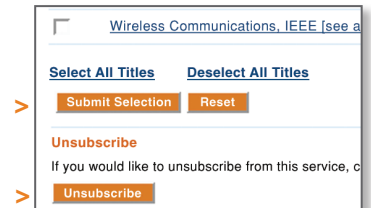
