



IEEE MEDAL IN POWER ENGINEERING

The IEEE Medal in Power Engineering was established in August 2008.

It may be presented to an individual, for outstanding contributions to the technology associated with the generation, transmission, distribution, application and utilization of electric power for the betterment of society.

The first presentation is scheduled for June 2010.

In the evaluation process, the following criteria are considered: shall include impact on the profession and the betterment of society, succession of significant technical or other contributions, leadership in accomplishing worthwhile goal(s), previous honors, and other achievements as evidenced by publications or patents or other evidence.

The award consists of a gold medal, bronze replica, certificate and cash honorarium.
